

Sorrento / Verona BBQ Set with Side Table Assembly Instructions

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION – PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

Due to the weight of some of the parts, a minimum of two people are required for construction of this barbecue.

To avoid injury always take care when lifting heavy parts and work in a clear area free of tripping hazards.

DO NOT allow children around the barbecue whilst constructing the barbecue.

A level and solid base should be prepared prior to constructing the barbecue.

Important - Adhesive Safety

The adhesive supplied with your barbecue contains cement and should be handled with care.

Please wear protective gloves when mixing and using the adhesive and avoid direct contact with your skin. We also recommend wearing eye protection and taking care not to breathe in any dust when mixing.

If the adhesive comes into contact with your skin, wash the area thoroughly with water. If it gets into your eyes, rinse immediately with plenty of clean water and seek medical advice.

Keep the adhesive out of the reach of children.

Constructing your barbecue

Before starting, put on protective gloves and suitable eye protection. Mix some of the adhesive with water to a smooth consistency in preparation for fixing the parts.

It is important not to mix all of the adhesive at once to avoid the adhesive drying out before construction is finished.

All joints should be fixed using adhesive.

The side table can be placed on the left or right side of the BBQ.

Step 1.

Place the base section on a solid surface and ensure it is level.



Step 2.

Place the leg piece 50mm from the edge of the base.



Step 3.

Place the back piece (580x500mm) into position next to the leg at the back of the base



Step 4.

Place the second leg making sure there is a 580mm gap between the two leg fronts.



Step 5.

Place the arch piece between the front legs.



Step 6.

Choose the side for your table and place table base piece (620x330mm)



Step 7.

Add side table back piece (580x500mm)



Step 8.

Add bullnose table side support piece (500x250mm)



Step 9.

Fit the BBQ top shelf with the side table locating hole to the correct side.



Step 10.

Fill the locating hole with adhesive and attach the side table top.



Step 11.

Attach first grill side piece



Step 12.

Attach grill back with granite cover



Step 13.

Place the insulation pad on the table top.



Step 14.

Place the granite tiles on the insulation pad.



Step 15.

Attach second grill side piece



Step 16.

Attach chimney bell with a 10mm overhang at the front.



Step 17.

Attach chimney pieces 2 and 3.



Step 18.

Attach the chimney cap



Step 19.

Place metal grill box and your masonry BBQ is ready to use.



VERY IMPORTANT

If possible, keep your BBQ covered during the winter to protect the stone and help it to last longer.

This Barbecue is made from natural stone and cast concrete, with use, small cracks may appear, this is normal and does not affect performance or usage.
