

Sorrento/ Verona Barbecue Fitting Instructions

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

Due to the weight of some of the parts, a minimum of two people are required for construction of this barbecue.

To avoid injury always take care when lifting heavy parts and work in a clear area free of tripping hazards.

DO NOT allow children around the barbecue whilst constructing the barbecue.

A level and solid base should be prepared prior to constructing the barbecue.

Important - Adhesive Safety

The adhesive supplied with your barbecue contains cement and should be handled with care.

Please wear protective gloves when mixing and using the adhesive and avoid direct contact with your skin. We also recommend wearing eye protection and taking care not to breathe in any dust when mixing.

If the adhesive comes into contact with your skin, wash the area thoroughly with water. If it gets into your eyes, rinse immediately with plenty of clean water and seek medical advice.

Keep the adhesive out of the reach of children.

Constructing your barbecue

Before starting, put on protective gloves and suitable eye protection. Mix some of the adhesive with water to a smooth consistency in preparation for fixing the parts.

It is important not to mix all of the adhesive at once to avoid the adhesive drying out before construction is finished. All joints should be fixed using adhesive.

STEP ONE

Place the base piece down and ensure it is level.



STEP TWO

Place the first leg 50mm in from the edge of the base.



STEP THREE

Place the back piece (580mm x 500mm) into position next to the leg.



STEP FOUR

Place the second leg into position, ensure that there is a 580mm gap between the front of the two legs as shown below.



STEP FIVE

Place the arch piece into the 580mm gap left between the legs.



STEP 6

Place the large top shelf on top of the now built base.

**STEP 7**

Place the grill side piece into position, ensuring it is inline with the base piece below it.



STEP 8

Place the grill back with granite cover into position, next to the grill side piece.

**STEP 9**

Place the insulation pad on the table top.



STEP 10

Place the two smaller granite tiles into position.

**STEP 11**

Place the second side grill piece into position.



STEP 12

Position the chimney bell onto the now complete grill area, leaving a 10mm overhang, as pictured below.

**STEP 13**

Place the chimney pieces one and two into position on top of the chimney bell.



STEP 14

The chimney cap can now be placed on top of the two chimney pieces.



STEP 15

Finally, place the metal grill box into the finished grilling area. Your barbecue is now ready to be used.



IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Wherever possible keep the barbecue covered during the winter months, as it will protect the stone and prolong the life of the barbecue.

Please bear in mind that this barbecue is manufactured from natural stone and cast concrete, it is possible with use, that cracks may appear, this is normal and does not affect the performance or use of the barbecue.
